REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR ENGAGEMENT OF A CONSULTANCY SERVICE ON THE PROVISION OF PHILIPPINE MARKET OF HERBAL MEDICINES, TRADITIONALLY-USED HERBAL MEDICINES, AND HEALTH SUPPLEMENTS FROM PHARMACIES, INDUSTRY SALES: DETERMINING THE HERBAL TRADITIONALLY-USED HERBAL MEDICINES, AND MEDICINES SUPPLY AND DEMAND SIZE IN THE PHILIPPINES (REBIDDING)

1. The Philippine Institute of Traditional and Alternative Health Care (PITAHC), through the General Appropriations Act for the year 2024 intends to apply the sum of Five Million Pesos (PhP5,000,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for ENGAGEMENT OF A CONSULTANCY SERVICE ON THE PROVISION OF PHILIPPINE MARKET OF HERBAL **MEDICINES**, **TRADITIONALLY-USED** HERBAL **MEDICINES**, AND HEALTH SUPPLEMENTS FROM PHARMACIES, INDUSTRY SALES: DETERMINING THE TRADITIONALLY-USED HERBAL MEDICINES, AND MEDICINES SUPPLY AND DEMAND SIZE IN THE PHILIPPINES (REBIDDING) with Reference No. CB 009-2024.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of *Three (3)* to Seven (7) consultants. Should only (1) or less than the required number apply for eligibility and short listing, pass the eligibility check, and /or pass the minimum score required in the shortlisting, the BAC shall consider the same. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

6. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using **non-discretionary "pass or fail"** criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

- 7. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the *Quality-Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS)* procedure. The Procuring Entity use the weights to be allocated for the Technical (60%) and Financial Proposals (40%) The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.
- 8. The contract shall be completed within *six* (6) *months*.

- 9. The *PITAHC* reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
